FELT BEADS EARRINGS TUTORIAL

The following is a list of basic requirements needed for the making of felt bead necklaces and earrings:

- 18.5 micron superfine Merino Wool
- Olive soap
- Warm water
- White vinegar
- Felting needle
- Knitting needle
- Darning needle
- Scissors
- Flat nose pliers
- Beading wire
- Beadalon velour tubing
- Leather or Japanese premium waxed cotton cord
- Gutterman waxed cotton cord – or similar

CHERRY EARRINGS



What you will need:

- Four felt beads approx ½" (15mm) in diameter
- Earring wires
- Two 6" (15cm) lengths of waxed cotton thread

Tie a firm knot in one end of waxed cotton, add a bead. Thread cord through earring wire and tie a loose knot, add another bead and tie a loose knot. When both earrings are hanging equally, finish off by firmly tying the loose knots.
